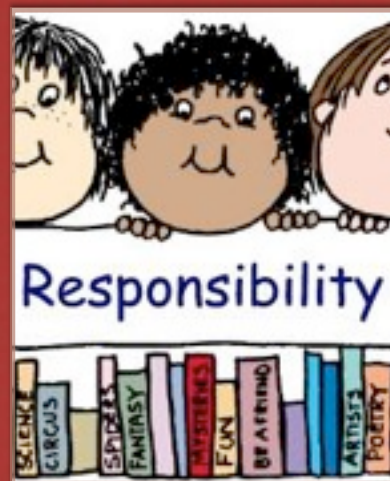
## SIXTH GRADE MOST VALUABLE VIKINGS FOR THE 1ST MARKING PERIOD
