Honorees, Veteran's, their families and the public are invited to attend this first time event for the Township. Members of our local, district and state government will be in attendance, and musical entertainment will be provided by the 78th Army Division Brass Ensemble as well as Ridge High School students Alex Wilke and NikiSumka. Additionally, several speakers will be on hand for the ceremony including the Honorable John Malay, Mayor of Bernards Township, Mr. Mike Armstrong, CEO of Community Hope, Inc., and Mr. James McLain, Associate Director, Lyons Campus of the Veterans Administration NJ Healthcare System. A reception is being held afterward for honorees and their families, Veterans, and dignitaries, and is hosted by Girl Scout Troop 154. Boy Scouts from throughout the Township will be on hand to assist with location of flags within the field, and for any special needs.
