Clothing

Socks, shower slippers, hand towels, thermal undergarments, hats, gloves, umbrellas/ponchos/raincoats- (*Can be gently used*)



Toiletries

Soap, shampoo/conditioner, razors and razor blades, deodorant, toothpaste/toothbrushes, shaving cream

Food

Canned meats, fruits and vegetables, pasta products, soups, cold and hot cereals, snacks (Chips, pretzels, crackers etc.)
