for Multiage under 18 Special Needs  
The **Embracing Creativity Project** is a wonderful opportunity for individuals with special needs to connect and explore their creativity with their neurotypical family members or friends. The vision for this class is to provide a nurturing environment that celebrates and honors each participant as a contributing artist within our community. The class will guide participants through SAORI Weaving and creative movement experiences as a means to develop relationships, and build a sense of group belonging and identity. Specific activities will reflect the needs and desires of the group.

### Creative Movement

Multiage & Family  
Do you enjoy exploring movement with your child or grandchild? Would you like to find a class that all of your children can enjoy together? This is a great class to explore what your body can do and how it can express a variety of ideas and feelings. After an invigorating warm-up, participants will share and explore their own movement ideas. This is a fantastic workshop to build confidence and relationships and is appropriate for all ages, developmental and physical capabilities.

### Creative Crafters

Ages 8-14 \$175 – six sessions\*  
This class offers artistic growth through the creation of various handmade crafts such as weaving, felting, and spinning from natural fiber, dyeing, sewing and knitting. Students can choose from multiple projects with different levels of expertise, including a Belt, Hat, Bag, Pillow, Hand Mitt or Tapestry. Projects are all hand-made from scratch.

### Semi-Private Creative Crafters:

Ages 8-Adult \$240 – six sessions\*  
Class meets for 90 minutes (Maximum 4 students per class). This semi-private class will allow for more students to select from detailed projects such as weaving on a personal loom to creating a project such as Pants, Jacket, Poncho, Pull-Over, or Scarf.

\*Choose your six 90-minute sessions between September 13, 2011 and December 13, 2011- Monday or Tuesday between 4-7 pm.
