

Senior Parking Procedures and Regulations 2018-19

All seniors must share a parking spot with another senior to be assigned on-site parking. There are no exceptions to this regulation including non-senior siblings, internships, EMT/firefighter positions or late arrival privileges.

Partners may choose to drive together or share their space. If sharing the space, only one partner may park on campus daily.

Partner applications must be turned in together.

200 senior parking spaces are available on the RHS campus. Parking spaces will be assigned to the first 200 sets of fully completed applications. The deadline for completed applications is Monday, April 23 unless the 200 on-campus spaces are filled prior to this date.

Students do not have to have obtained a driver's license to be assigned a parking spot.

Students must display parking tag at all times.

Parking Tag Pick-up is Thursday, August 30, 2018, 8-10AM outside the cafeteria

One partner may bring his or her partner's documents and fee on August 30th, however, the tag will be held for that partner to pick up the first week of school.

Partners must bring the following to Parking Tag Pick-up:

1. A PHOTOCOPY of both driver's license AND registration. If student has not obtained a driver's license, parking tag will be held until student presents a photocopy of license and registration
2. BOTH partners must pay a \$50 parking fee in the form of cash or check made out to RHS Student Activities on August 30th. Tags will not be given out until both partners pay the \$50 fee

Parking privileges and tag will be revoked if:

Student is found to be under the influence of a controlled and dangerous substance (Policy and Procedure M5530).

Student leaves campus without the permission of an administrator.

Student has chronic discipline and/or parking offenses including parking in spaces not his/her own, parking in Cedar Hill School/BOE lot, not displaying parking tag at all times, speeding or careless driving on campus.

A Motor Vehicle Summons will be issued if:

Student parks in a space other than their own.

Student parks in the Cedar Hill School/BOE lot.
