



Still time to join us for spring SOCCER (non travel)

In town Programs are listed below:

Cubs: The program for our youngest players, Cubs offers an introduction to soccer for boys and girls in Pre-K, Kindergarten, and 1st grade (generally ages 4, 5 and 6). In a fun but challenging environment, players learn to love the game while gaining the basic skills for soccer success. Participants receive 7 weeks of practice and in-town games; 1 practice and game per week.

Academy and Academy Select: This program builds from Cubs with a more intensive experience for U7 and U8 players (generally age 6 and 7, grades 1 and 2). The emphasis of the Academy is to create more touches and more experiences of the basic principles of the game (passing, shooting, spatial awareness), building most players towards success in travel soccer. Participants receive 2 days of training and Saturday in-town game day during a 9 week program, including some scrimmage festivals against other towns. The Select program, for which players must tryout, adds tournaments (at an additional cost)

Recreation: The largest single in town program at Berna, Recreation offers an in-town soccer experience for boys and girls from 2nd through 8th grade. Players of all skill levels may join Recreation, as there are no tryouts required. Players will be trained with an emphasis on developing their skills in a supportive and fun environment. Participants receive 7 weeks of practice and in-town games; 1 practice and game per week.

PEC Soccer: Special needs soccer for ages 4 to 14. Saturdays starting at 3 for ages 4 to 9 and 4:00 for ages 9 and up.
